

From the Pinetop Community Association Board Members;

The board has received numerous complaints from residents within our association over the abuse of ATV and off road equipment. The board has decided to hire off duty sheriff deputies to patrol and write tickets for such violations during holidays which is the time when most of these violations occur.

Please report any such issues you experience to the Navajo County Sheriff's department and it was recommended that photos or video would also be a good idea to share with the Sheriff when they respond to your call.

Operating Your ATV on Streets or Highways

You must have a class M driver licence for a 3 wheel ATV and a class D driver licence for a 4 wheel ATV.

- Your ATV must be registered.....Fine \$95.00
- Your ATV must be insured.....Fine \$914.00
- Registration and Proof of Insurance must be carried with ATV.....Fine \$500.00
- Persons under 18 ys. of age must wear a helmet.....Fine \$135.00
- All persons must wear eye protection.....Fine \$135.00
- You must not carry a passenger unless the vehicle is designed for it.....Fine \$135.00

Equipment

To register and operate an ATV on a street or highway an ATV must have the following:

- At least one brake that can be operated by either hand or foot.....Fine \$135.00
- Brake light.....Fine \$135.00
- At least one but not more than two headlights that shine at least five hundred feet ahead.....Fine \$135.00
- At least one taillight, visible for at least five hundred feet to the rear..Fine \$135.00
- At least one red reflector if not part of the taillight.....Fine \$135.00
- Current and Valid licence plate fastened to the rear of the ATV.....Fine \$135.00
- Licence Plate Light.....Fine \$135.00
- Horn Audible from a distance of at least two hundred feet.....Fine \$135.00
- Muffler in good working order and in constant operation.....Fine \$135.00
(Muffler cut out or bypass prohibited)
- Rear View Mirror.....Fine \$135.00
- Seat and foot rest for the operator.....Fine \$135.00
- Fuel Tank Cap.....Fine \$135.00

Windshields are not required for ATV's

These are not all of the possible violations but simply a sampling of the potential fines.
